DISTRICT FOUNDATION OFFERS CLUB AND SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS

Every year, the WI-UM Kiwanis District Foundation gives out club grants and matching scholarship grants. During the 2019-2020 Kiwanis year, the foundation awarded club grants to Alger County, Barron, Portage, Whitewater Breakfast, and Wisconsin Dells totaling \$8,750. The District Foundation also awarded \$9,750 in matching college scholarships. During the 2020-2021 Kiwanis year, the foundation awarded club grants to Alger County, Eau Claire Clear Water, Oshkosh and Richland Center totaling \$3,860 (the number was lower last year because fewer clubs requested grants). The District Foundation also awarded \$11,205 in matching college scholarships.
