

Inter-club Numbers

Effective October 1, 2004 clubs with 20 or fewer members need a minimum of two members in attendance to constitute an inter-club meeting. Clubs with 21 to 30 members need three members and clubs with 31 or more members need at least four members in attendance.

Round Robin Interclub Award

Starting October 1, 2013

“The award shall be administered by the Executive Director. The Executive Director’s determination of any winner of the Interclub Award shall be based on evidence of interclub visits as reported in the Official Monthly Club report.” (October 1st to September 30th). The Club President or Club Secretary must submit their Club Name to the Executive Director for consideration of the Round Robin Interclub Award no later than November 15th.

To earn the Round Robin Interclub Award the following criteria shall apply:

A club must interclub with clubs at least **ten (10) times** during the administrative year.

Each club in the division must visit their sponsored youth club at least once during the administrative year.

A club may credit interclub visits in other division, district, or countries providing official visit certification is given to the home club secretary.

An interclub must be recorded on the Club’s Official Monthly Report in order to receive credit.
