Community service / Fundraising

The Committee will attempt to expand the Club's impact on issues of national and international significance. Committee shall also facilitate the weekly meeting prayer/inspirational moment by encouraging all members to participate and ensuring the responsibility is filled for each meeting.

Membership

To increase membership and membership engagement in the Club. The Committee is responsible for managing the membership application process and submitting recommendations to the Board. The Committee shall facilitate marketing and PR activities, striving to keep the Club visible in the community via local and social media. This committee is responsible for website management, which may involve professional subcontracting. Membership induction, orientation, recognition and awards, interclub activities and conference participation originate within this committee.

Service Leadership Programs (SLP)
