 - c) How will this award improve your life?

SUBMISSION OF COMMUNITY AWARD REQUEST

Award requests will be assessed by the Newburgh Kiwanis Club Grants Committee **annually**. The deadline for receipt of application is **April 30th**

Award winners will be notified within 45 days of deadline

Three finalists will be chosen based on their essay to attend an informal mixer hosted by the Newburgh Kiwanis Club at which time they will be required to further discuss the above essay criteria (date to be determined)

Award winners must attend a Newburgh Kiwanis Club lunch meeting to receive their award (date to be determined)

Applications **MUST BE** postmarked before April 30th
(requests received after April 30th will be eliminated from consideration)
