OUR NEWS.....Looking quite fit, Jim Vine (Right) returned to our meeting last week taking the time to relate his harrowing experience while undergoing surgery and then the long recovery. Good to see you back Jim!......Our pancake breakfast will be held April $10^{\rm th}$ without Dave Norton . Bo Rog is in charge and he's asking for your help. The sign-up sheet will be at today's meeting so don't hesitate to lend a hand – *Pancakes & French Toast.......*The Scholarship Foundation Board will be selecting the 2016 recipients beginning April $8^{\rm th}$ and introducing them at our meeting on May17th.

In review of our March 8th speaker's presentation we heard from Joanne Clemens – Senior Manager Corporate Relations of the Greater Cleveland Food Bank.



The "bank" is housed in a 100,000 sq. ft. building located South of I-90 on S. Waterloo Road East of E. 152nd Street. It serves within a six county area with food and meals for the While working with 850 agencies it helped serve 47 million meals in 2015 and is now planning to serve 58 million in 2016. Forty-four percent of the meals are served to children while 73% are served to families earning below the poverty level of \$23,000 for a family of four. The three main reasons for the need for help are; change in employment, loss of housing and health issues. The bank's three year goal includes closing the gap on the needs of "home bound seniors, children, and to work with other organizations on medical and housing needs. For a one-dollar donation the bank can supply food for four meals through its capacity of receiving large quantities of donated food and its large quantity purchasing power. The bank has partnered with 600 corporate sponsors. And while working with Harvest for Hunger they were able to raise \$4 million dollars in just seven weeks. We were reminded to ask our grocery clerks how we might make a donation at the checkout, \$1.5 million was donated at checkouts in 2015 in this way. All major groceries have agreed to cooperate. The bank utilizes the services of 13,000 volunteers annually while working in two hour shifts helping sort donated food, load its twelve trucks and in many other ways
