Our guest speaker last week was the Rev. Hilton O. Smith, current President of the Greater Cleveland NAACP. Rev. Smith took office just one year ago and has been instrumental in bringing new initiatives to the organization. Work on critical issues including veteran and adult mental health issues, bullying, and education and job opportunities. Under Rev. Smith's leadership the organization has gone beyond civil rights issues and has become more "community needs" oriented. A task force has been formed to study poverty in our community while over 7% of Ohio citizens are living with some element of poverty. Mentoring of students has been increased to encourage youths to continue their education and to stay in the area upon graduation. The U.S. now ranks 26th in the world for education quality and 18th in math and sciences. Rev. Smith feels a top priority in education must include the evaluation of teachers and their ability to teach students adequately. Downtown Cleveland is now the home of over 13,000 residents with young professionals beginning to stay and raise families there.
