Ken Kirchner (L) & Jon Schmittgen of Solutions At Work (S.A.W.) attended our meeting last week to tell us about Community Supported Agriculture (C.S.A.). Cleveland Crops is a program of SAW, Inc. and the Cuyahoga County Board of Developmental Disabilities. It is the Mission Statement of Cleveland Crops to provide employment, training, career growth and customized support for persons with developmental disabilities.

Cleveland Crops employ and train individuals to grow produce using sustainable and integrated pest management practices. Each week June through October the fresh produce is harvested daily, thoroughly washed packaged and the same day made available to individuals who have previously purchased a Full Share or Single Share. The "share" boxes are made up each week of fresh produce picked the same day and taken to pick-up sites all guaranteed to be premium and fresh. The produce ranges from over a hundred varieties of fruits and vegetables. A newsletter is also available containing receipts and ideas for healthy eating.
