"THIS-N-THAT FROM LAST WE MET"

With 92 miles of roads, 17% poverty and the average age of residents at 34 years, Lakewood Mayor Michael Summers took this time to outline several significant and aggressive plans for Lakewood in 2014. Among them were: adding another 6,000 recycling bins to the already 6,000 used by residents..... \$2.3 million upgrade resurfacing Madison Avenue.....demolishing McKinley School to possibly build 34 townhouse units....creating a walking path in Kaufman Park, and an upgrade for Madison Park.....begin a plan to provide improved lakefront access and to provide "Solstice Steps" where lingering and viewing of Lakewood's sun sets will be improved at Lakewood Park.....to constantly monitor residential water consumption electronically to detect system leaks thereby saving resident's dollars.....installation of electronic transmissions to RTA stops indicating when the next bus will arrive.....alternating sides of street parking on Woodward Avenue to reduce speeding.....use of flying drones to monitor the lake front and outflow water facilities.... complete the city's wireless communications facilities of safety and services.....tearing down of the Westwood Theater as it has now become a safety hazard.....repairs to all city sidewalks that have become hazardous to pedestrians.

The mayor's presentation went into more detail as to the cost and extent of these city improvements.

Mayor Summers will present a "State of the City Address" March 4, 7:00 P.M. at the Lakewood Masonic Temple, 15700 Detroit Avenue.
