This-N-That From Last We Met!

Our guest speaker, Judge Joan Synenburg's presentation dealt with one of today's most significant issues. As one of 34 judges in Cuyahoga County, Judge Synenburg is one of two judges dealing specifically with drug and alcohol abuse cases. Abuses may begin in different ways, currently the most common is by misuse of pain killer prescription drugs. To compound the abuse are the 25% of those addicted who also having mental health issues. *The drug courts are specifically designed to find help for those needing it and to monitor their success through a court ordered prescribed help program. Each year, in the United States, the number of convicts released from prisons amount to the population of Baltimore, Maryland. - 623,000. Judge Synenburg urges everyone to dispose of unused prescription drugs properly and not to hoard or dispense them to friends or family members.*
