## Spotlight On.....

The year was 1972, the month was June, the exact date may have been the 13<sup>th</sup>, the place was where many of us will be standing on Tuesday, the Lakewood Kiwanis Pavilion in Lakewood Park.

Just 44 years ago Bobby Fischer won the World Chess Championship, "Godfather" won an Academy Award for Best Picture, George Wallace was shot while campaigning for President and five men carrying cameras and surveillance equipment were arrested at the Watergate Hotel in Washington D.C. Both Republican and Democratic Conventions were held in Miami Beach and in December the final moon mission, Apollo 17, would begin.

"Ted Wagner (1971-1972) was President of Lakewood Kiwanis that year and it was a very satisfying year for us. On that day in June 1972, 145 members and guests attended the official dedication of our Kiwanis Pavilion at Lakewood Park. Mayor Lawther was there as well as members of city council and Pete McGrew planned the program."

Lakewood Kiwanis had raised \$20,000 to build the pavilion. (From Lakewood Kiwanis Historic Minute 1972)
