At our Business Meeting last Tuesday we heard from our



Eliminate Chairman Tim Mohr who also wears the hat of Membership Chair. Following is Tim's club report. Paid and Pledged Gifts - \$39,571.33; 65.9% towards our goal of \$60,000; average \$gift = \$487.83; lives saved or protected = 18,000.

Kiwanis International - Gifts Pledged and Paid - \$101,630,437. Lives saved or protected - 56,461,354.

Ohio District - Gifts Pledged & Paid - \$2,641,797.31; lives saved & protected 1,463,640. Pledges still outstanding in Ohio - \$423,984.19; lives yet to be saved - 1,417,665.

Noteworthy progress: 18 countries remain at risk for maternal and neonatal tetanus; 41 out of 59 priority countries have been validated for MNT elimination. Validation assessments are anticipated this year in Ethiopia, Pakistan, the Philippines, Haiti, Chad, Kenya and Nigeria.
