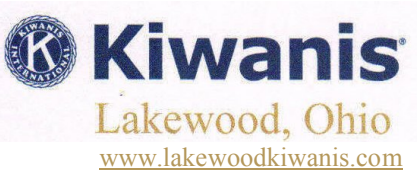

August 6, Saturday, Lakewood Arts Festival. KCL hot dog fundraiser The KCL is sponsoring the 3rd Place Trophy.

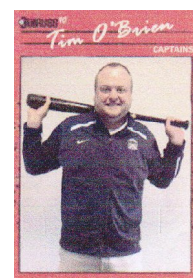
September 10, Saturday, The Community Festival, at Madison Park, Lakewood, with our Pete's Table fundraiser and FREE Book Give Away.

The D.A.R. had set an ambitious goal to literally set a new world record in Patriotism! The letters were taken to the 125th Continental Congress during the week of June 15, 2016. They far surpassed their goal by having an official count of 101,000 plus letters and setting a new world record.
