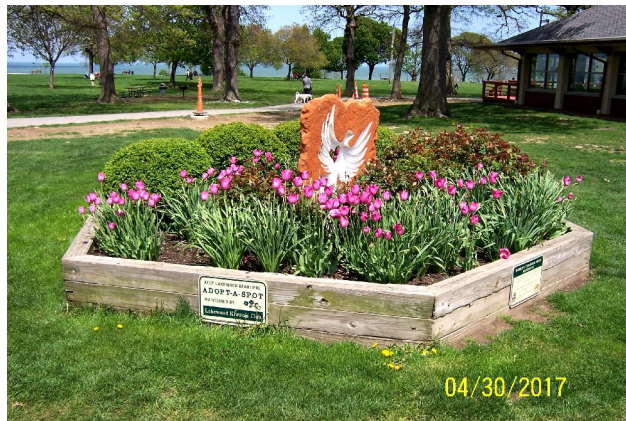

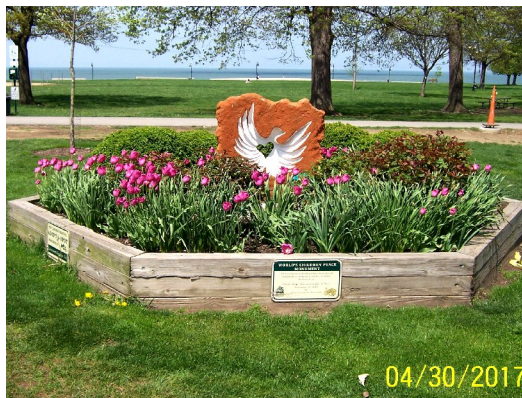


The Lakewood Kiwanis Garden in Lakewood Park

Dr. Robert McMahon, PhD was our speaker last week. Dr. McMahon's expertise is in Horticulture and Greenhouse Technologies. He was employed by the Ohio State University Agricultural Technical Institute, Wooster, Ohio from 1987-2015. Among his many responsibilities was the managing of five production / teaching greenhouses and campus conservatory and teaching greenhouse production courses. However, at our meeting Dr. McMahon came to the level of interest of many of our members highlighted by the many and varied questions that were asked. His topic: the Care & Feeding of Houseplants which included testing the soil with your finger to the second knuckle to feel the need for watering and to water only when the soil is completely dry and to water thoroughly around the plants root system. Plants receiving direct sunlight for several hours a day and are rapidly growing should be fertilized every two to four weeks from late Spring through early fall if you feed each time you water; "Constant Feeding" care must be taken not to burn the roots with too much fertilizing.
