From Ohio District Club Growth Chair for Division 14, Jodee Ward, the following Year to Date numbers are:

As of October 2013 Ohio District had 237 Clubs with 7,780 members. As of April 2014 the district had 7,940 members an increase of +240 members for the term. For the same period our Division 14 showed a total membership of 359 members and in September and 361 in April of this year for a total increase of +2 members. Four of our division's clubs showed an increase for the period with Bay Village Kiwanis showing an increase of +1 member, North Olmsted Kiwanis +3 members, West Park Kiwanis with +1 member and Westlake Kiwanis has a +1 member. Four of the ten clubs in our division showed no change in membership totals or lost members.

John Mumma has been really putting the effort into the "Read Around The World" program of providing FREE books to school age children. John reports "Hitting the Mother Load" by arranging for 600 books to add to our inventory of books to be given away at our fundraisers.

John has already brought in half the number last week and will once again need help early, before the meeting, on Tuesday to unload the other 300 books. Volunteers are needed to help!
