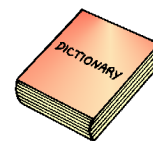

A new KCL project for this year is to donate dictionaries to fourth and fifth grade students in our area.



In keeping with Ohio Governor Flinta's first family project of encouraging clubs within Ohio to support the Ohio Kiwanis Governor by completing reading literacy related service projects within their community, President Jim and our Board of Directors have instituted a plan to supply local school children with a dictionary for their level of reading skills.

Other local organizations have taken on similar projects to benefit public school children in our area. Our focus will be to put these dictionaries in the hands of local parochial school children. With this as our goal 144 dictionaries will be donated to St. Marks Catholic School in West Park, 45 copies will go to Lakewood Catholic Academy and 10 will go to Lakewood Lutheran School. Plans are to continue this project in the future.
