During the PREVIEW SALE you must be a "Friend" of the library - register at the desk for a nominal fee.

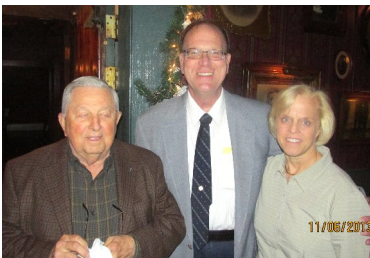
Children's books will be for sale at a cost of 10¢ ea.
