New entries are coming in daily and as you see in the photos preparations are being made for a successful fundraiser. Final registrations took place on October 4th.

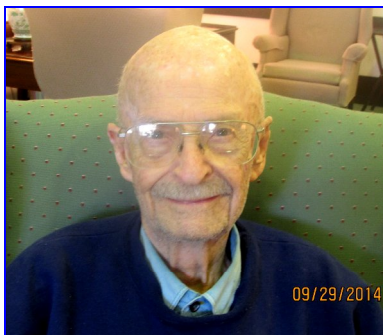
