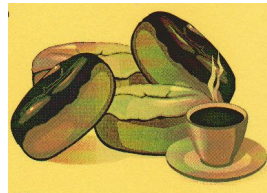

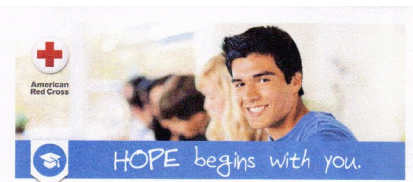

### From the Archives - 1933!

**Lakewood Kiwanis**, led by President Harry Hold, boasted 91 members. The Kiwanis Minstrel Show took place in March at Lakewood High school, with proceeds benefiting Lakewood's underprivileged children. Each member was required to sell 10 tickets apiece....Each ticket only cost a quarter!

Also in March, the first annual "Old Timers Day" welcomed all former members as our guest. That meeting attracted 126 people. "Old Timers Day" was very popular for many years.

We were the 6<sup>th</sup> Division Bowling Champions again that year, as Lou Roller fired a 3-game total of 596.

In June, the Board passed a resolution saying that "dues were free" from July through December. We still charged for lunch, however....40 cents for members-60 cents for guests!

The Kiwanis Lodge opened again in June; filled to capacity with 70 boys enrolled.
