United Way advances the common good by focusing on education, income and health - the building blocks for a good quality of life. United Way recruits people and organizations who bring the passion, expertise, and resources needed to get things done. More so than in the past, UWSC is focusing upon community engagement. They are organizing Community Conversations, which are a series of meetings designed to learn about social issues facing Ames and explore potential solutions to them. In March and April of this year, UWSC met with 11 groups (124 individuals), representing a broad range of social demographic characteristics, staff and clients of their partner agencies, young professionals, ISU students, seniors, members of the business community, members of the faith community, and educators. UWSC asked these individuals and representatives of groups, organizations, and agencies about their concerns, their opinions about what prevents progress in addressing these concerns, and ideas about what might be done to make a difference in reducing and mitigating the negative consequences of social problems in Ames. The outcome of these meetings was to focus on Education, Income, and Health. UWSC is seeking additional collaborations and partnerships to continue this process of community building.
