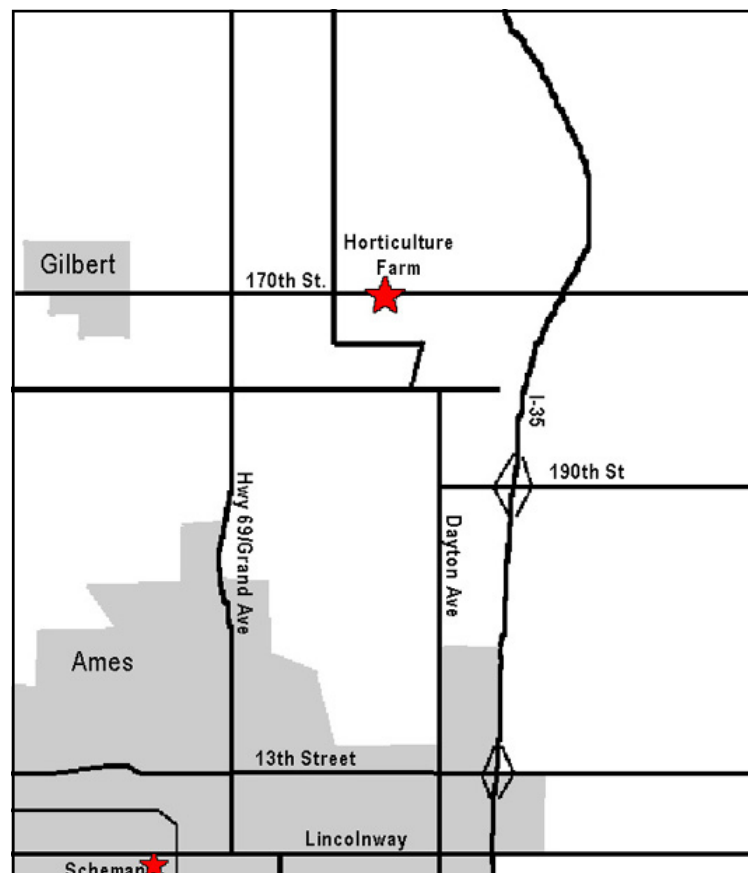
TREASURER NEEDED
