## PROJECT REPORTS

- **Apple Sales.** Club member Paul Domoto set us in motion for our annual apple project. Wholesale prices will be the same as this past year.
  - Unfortunately, some apples will show some scars from hail damage.
  - We no longer sell Red Delicious, but sell a new apple called the Enterprise.
  - Sales begin on September 30th and conclude on October 28th.
  - We will distribute apples at the ISU Horticulture Research Station on November 11th.

- **Food Shelf.** Thank you to Carl and Ginny Anderson, Cynthia Gaunt, Ken Larson, Doug and Kris Meinhard, Gary and Sue Osweiler, Gary Wade, and Don and Mary Ellen Wishart for helping Bernie collect food each week.
- **Project Eliminate.** Kiwanis International has joined with USAID and UNICEF to Eliminate Maternal-Neonatal Tetanus. We need \$11k to reach our goal of becoming a model club.
