K-FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION - 2018

The Grand Junction Kiwanis Club is offering scholarships for deserving Key Club members who attend any accredited institution of higher learning. Scholarship awards will be announced by April 30, 2018.

CRITERIA:

1. Recipients must be active in a Key Club for at least one school year in a Mesa County Valley School District #51 high school.
2. The Committee will have broad latitude in determining the amount of the scholarship award and the number of scholarships to be awarded each year. The Committee may elect to award no scholarships if there are no qualified applicants. The Committee is not required to award the same amount of money to recipients. The Committee may award a part of or all of the Kiwanis Foundation K Family Scholarship Fund (hereinafter the "Fund") balance for scholarships in any given year.
3. The Committee will consider applicants activities in his or her church, community and school.
4. Scholarship money may only be used for undergraduate tuition, housing, books and fees at an accredited college or university in the United States. Distributions from the Fund will be made payable directly to the educational institution.
5. The recipient must be enrolled in at least twelve (12) semester hours of study at the time of payment from the Fund.
6. Generally, awards will be made only to graduating high school seniors. However, at the discretion of the Committee, Scholarships may be awarded in succeeding years if the recipient demonstrates academic ability while in college with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and if the recipient is making satisfactory progress toward receiving a degree (the GPA eligibility applies to the prior academic year for an applicant who is presently in college).
7. A student may receive this scholarship a maximum of two times.
8. If a recipient loses eligibility, the amount of the award will be returned to Kiwanis.
9. The Applicant will file with the Committee an application in such form as is established by the Committee. The Committee may reject any application if the form is incomplete or if the Committee determines the information is inaccurate or if the Applicant does not meet the criteria established by the Committee.
10. The Committee will consider financial need (although the award may be made even if financial need is not shown), scholastic ability (although the Committee may consider factors other than only the GPA), individual personality of the applicant (does the applicant get along with people, have a positive attitude and outlook on life, is the applicant socially oriented and involved in school and civic affairs, is the applicant a good citizen), and scholastic and social goals (is there a future commitment to school, business and civic matters).

PROCEDURE:

11. Obtain an application from the Grand Junction Kiwanis Club.

13. An interview will be requested and scheduled in March or April.
14. Awards will be paid directly to the registrar at the scholarship recipient's selected institution unless otherwise determined by the selection Committee. After the scholarship is awarded, the recipient will be required to provide proof of enrollment.
