Program: Dane County Sheriff Dave Mahoney, who started law enforcement 34 years, described some changes that have occurred since becoming sheriff in 2007. The biggest change since 2007 was eliminating need to send prisoners to other states and other Wisconsin counties. More than 2000 people are released and monitored by a very accurate bracelet monitor. They have had a 97 percent success rate. Failures result by not following the rules of this system. Using this system saves the county \$22 million. Future issues include need for new jail, prisoner health, and heroine use.
