**Program:** Andy Paulios, manager of Wildlife Ecology for Dane County discussed What's up with Whips and Nighthawks too. The population of whip-poor-wills has been decreasing in Wisconsin potentially due to forest cutover recovery, fire suppression, human development and decline in food. They feed by night flying catching insects such as moths, beetle and mosquitoes. They have two egg nests which can be found on the ground in forested grassy area. A network of bird watchers have been working to estimate their populations in Wisconsin. The nighthawk population is decreasing in Wisconsin and feed on flying insects. They also have two egg nests which tend to be found on gravel surfaces which can be on building rooftops.
