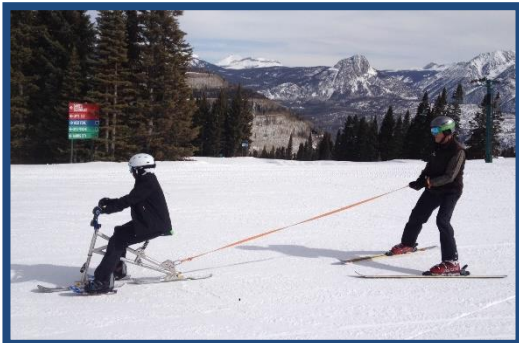
# KIWANOGRAM
