Sara Pickrell, director of the Dane County Girls on the Run Council, described this nation wide program for girls in third - fifth grade. The national organization started in 1996 in North Carolina with a mission of inspiring girls to be joyful, healthy and confident using a fun, experience based curriculum which creatively integrates running. The curriculum has two sessions per year with each session being ten weeks with two meetings per week.

The first Dane County program was at the Shorewood Elementary school in the spring of 2005. In Dane County 830 girls participated and 225 volunteers in the spring, 2014. Programs are conducted at elementary schools and community centers. Some of the many topics covered are peer pressure, understanding cooperation and learning about community. The program culminates in a service project and a 5K run.
