Program:

Steve Cover, director of the Department of Planning and Community and Economic Development, City of Madison, presented The Resilient City-Madison for the 21st Century. Changes having an impact on the city master plan are 1. demographic, 2. economic and technological and 3. climate for resource availability. City resiliency was defined as the ability to recover from or easily adjust to misfortune or change. Steve cited Cedar Rapids (major flood) and Detroit (major population decrease).

In the planning process, sustainability is obtained by being adaptability, diversity, redundancy, and positioning. Some considerations in the planning process at 1. by 2030, 1 in 5 people will be over 65, 2. by 2042, no majority race will exist in U.S., and 3. the majority of the households will be single persons. In Madison 25 percent are government employees, 1 in 5 are college graduates and retailing is changing-more mail/online purchases.

The master plan will include future neighborhoods where housing is a part of retail stores and restaurants much like Hilldale Shopping Center with housing added on Midvale and the Sequoya Commons on Midvale with a library, restaurants, retail and housing in one facility.
