## Program:

Jeremy Glinside, Annual and Alumni Giving director, described the Kiwanis International Foundation mission and grant program, was established in 1940. Each Kiwanis Club is encouraged to contribute to the foundations. Madison West Kiwanis has been contributing \$250 each year.

The mission of the foundation is to assist Kiwanis International in serving the children of the world. The vision of the foundation is to extend our Kiwanis impact. Kiwanis family grants are available to clubs, districts and district foundations. Applications are available on line and are due two times per year: April 15 and November 15. The foundation awarded twenty-six grants during July, 2014 (applications submitted April 15).

The Foundation manages worldwide projects such as The Eliminate program, Maternal Neonatal Tetanus. This project has generated \$66 million and has one year remaining to reach a goal of \$110 million. Madison West has contributed \$2,730 to this project.
