Program:

Charlie Price, Division 3 Lt. Governor, provided training on the Kiwanis International Youth Protection Guidelines which all Kiwanis members are expected to receive. This training is expected to occur annually for all Kiwanians. Some of the guidelines are:

1. Criminal history background checks may be required of all members working with youth. With our activities with Midvale School these checks are done through the school.
2. Use the rule of three when transporting youth must be used. A minimum of three people in the car with one or two adults.
3. Overnight stays, one male adult for each ten male youth and one female adult for each ten females.
4. All medication must have written permission of parents or guardian.
5. Report troubling behavior involving youth.
6. Treat youth personal information as confidential.
7. Avoid the initiation of social media networking with youth.
8. Avoid the use of alcoholic beverages and tobacco products
9. Refrain from counseling youth.

A copy of the Kiwanis International Guidelines will be sent to all members for your reference. Members attending today's will be recognized as receiving this training. Your secretary is asked to maintain a record of members receiving this training.
