Program: Dick Fayran briefly described the Ice Age Trail and discussed his hobby of photographing scenes on the trail and creating water colors from the photographs.

The trail follows the terminal moraine of the last Ice Age. The length of the planned trail is 1,200 miles with a 600 miles completed. Support for developing the trail was established in 1980 using federal funds. The trail goes through 30 Wisconsin counties and is located only in Wisconsin. The trail is designed for hiking and much of the trail development is done by volunteers.
