Program: Bob Bradley, former Madison West Kiwanian, described his work activities after he retired from the Food Science Department, UW-Madison in 2001. He joined the faculty in 1964 as an assistant professor. He continues to teach sensory analysis of dairy products including butter, milk, ice cream, cottage cheese, cheddar cheese and yogurt. He teaches short courses for people from industry and is responsible for laboratory courses on dairy cheeses and fluid butter.

Bob has served as advisor to the collegiate dairy products judging team for 38 years. The judging team has won several national collegiate championships.

A video was shown where Bob was coaching members of the judging team where he was showing and describing some quality characteristics of several cheese samples.

Bob indicated some lower priced ice cream has as much as 50 percent air. He suggested when selecting milk in grocery store, do not take the milk at the front of the cooler, due deterioration due to light.
