Some special club recognition and accomplishments include:

1. Named one of the top five clubs in the nation for financial literacy and educational programming.
2. The only club that provides a full service credit union.
3. The only club in the nation with an AVID partnership and connection with schools.
4. 50,000 meals are served per year, the club is planning a new kitchen.
5. The club is planning to hire a dentist to serve the much needed dental care.
6. 250 young people were connected to internships with 35 local companies.
7. 172 professionals provide programs for the club.
8. Currently serve 6,300 young people.
