Program: Dan Stein describe the accomplishments, challenges and opportunities faced by Second Harvest Food Bank of Southern Wisconsin. Hunger is related to families and struggling primarily financially.

Second Harvest distributes food to food pantries in southwestern Wisconsin (16 counties). In this area one in nine people experience hunger. Many experience other health issues.

Forty percent of food produced on farms is wasted. Money is not the problem but logistics, moving the food. One of seven truckloads going to grocery stores are thrown away (examples: dented cans and missing labels). Some programs to address this issue are Midwest mixing center, field to food bank, and repurpose food such apples to apple sauce acorn squash to soup.
