Program: Dr. Conrad Andringa discussed Myths of Immunization with respect to children and adults. One myth was that measles shot caused autism, which was based on a study in Great Britain with seven children. The study was funded by the plaintiffs in a court case and proven completely incorrect even though the study was published in a well recognized medical journal.

Dr. Andringa feels nothing compares to immunizations as a impact on human health. He rated immunizations as having the greatest impact on human health. Rated second was analysis devices such as MRI's and cat scans while the impact in developments from cancer research was rated third.
