Program: Oncology Research was today's program presented by Dr. Joshua Lang, assistant professor in the UW- Madison Medical School Hematology/Oncology Division. His specialty is medical oncology with a sub-specialty in genitourinary cancer. He has done research in many cancer areas: prostate, renal, testicular and gall bladder.

Dr. Lang is one of the leaders in the Carbone Cancer Center established in 1973 by Drs. Raush and Carbone who had worked on cancer for years.

Some cancer facts provided by Dr. Lang:

1. Viruses cause 20 percent of the cancers,
2. Bone marrow transplants are a leading cure for cancers, (first successful in 1968)
3. Two important targeted drug developments are Trop2 and IMMU132
