Locating their new facilities in southeast Wisconsin, Foxconn wanted to be Representative Ryan’s congressional district, because he may have major role in new tariffs, also it located near input suppliers, many in the Chicago area. Wisconsin does not have any of Foxconn’s supplier’s. Illinois will further benefit, because a large proportion of Foxconn’s employees will be living in Illinois.

Environment is another major concern because the Foxconn facility will have a high water requirement. Some state environmental rules have been relaxed to benefit Foxconn.
