Program: "Wisconsin On the Air -100 years of Public Broadcasting in the State Where It Started" was presented by Jack Mitchell who was the former director of Wisconsin Public Radio. The origin of public broadcasting in Wisconsin was due to the progressive movement, 1900-15. This movement involved breaking up large corporations and providing the people with greater control of government.

In 1912, the Wisconsin Idea was born which was intended to help people to move ahead personally. Cooperative Extension was established about that time, which provided education to rural areas. In 1917, a physicist at the university was able make a radio to function which was coupled to an attempt of the Wisconsin Idea to reach out to the citizens of Wisconsin. Early radio was used to provide information to farmers and homemakers. In 1920's, attempts were made to add fine arts and political information.

In 1945, the state established a radio council and funding to support FM radio stations throughout the state. Although home radios were not available but radio kits were made available to the rural citizens.
