Program: The "Affordable Care Act" (ACA) was described by John T. (Tim) Harrington who has a MD degree from UW-Madison and 47 years experience as a rheumatologist. He is a member of Downtown Kiwanis.

Initial implementation of ACA began in 2014 and was scheduled to take effect over a 10 years and then revised as needed. The goals of ACA are to improve access to affordable health insurance, limit rising insurance costs and limit the high costs of health care in the U. S. Implementation of ACA has been delayed and compromised by political opposition and then criticized for being ineffective. Problems of starting the Federal Insurance Exchange caused frustration and stalled the process. Access varies by state where Medicaid expansion has been rejected by 19 states, including Wisconsin. The future of health care depends on the outcome of the 2016 election. ACA could be repealed and insurance cost would increase.
