Registering for the list does not eliminate all unwanted calls. Exemptions to the list include non-profit/tax exempt organizations, individuals, opinion polls, and responses to your request for a free item. Most telemarketers originate from out of state or out of country. Many of these calls are referred to as 'spoofing calls' where the caller's number appears to be local or coming from Washington DC.

The IRS does not call taxpayers, only corresponds by mail. More scams occur in April, tax time. Never give out personal information.
