Program: High Speed Networking in Madison was presented by Barry Orton, Professor Emeritus in telecommunications in professional development and applied studies, UW-Madison. Barry has expertise in telecommunications policy, internet utilization, cable television regulation and media industries. He frequently advises cities and other municipalities regarding these telecommunication issues.

Broadband accessibility is the limiting factor with high speed electronic communication in most homes and in rural areas. To gain this access fiber optic cable connection must be made to these areas. The current twisted copper wire is very limiting in communicating. It worked well with phones and some additional communication over the lines. The estimated cost for Madison is \$150 million.

One of the largest groups of people affected are those working from home requiring high levels of telecommunications.
