Guests: At Madison East Kiwanis Club Meeting.

Program: This week’s meeting was joint with Madison East Kiwanis. Wisconsin-Upper Michigan Kiwanis District Governor, Justin Hahn, discussed his background and his goals for the district.

Justin has a long history in the Kiwanis Family. He was a member of Key Club while attending high school and a Circle K member at Carthage College, the first Circle K Club. He joined the Waterford Kiwanis Club where served as club president. Later he served as Lt. Governor. He became district governor on October 1, 2017.

He has set a number goals for the district during his year as governor:

1. Charter two new Kiwanis clubs-one club (Grafton) has been chartered and soon two more clubs will be chartered,
2. Service hours of 100,000 hrs- at 22,409 (Madison West Kiwanis has 342 hours),
3. Interclubs – 350 – at 72, (Madison West Kiwanis has 7)
4. Clubs submitting monthly reports – 100 – at 80 (Madison West Kiwanis is one),
5. Funding - \$1 million at 258,155, (Madison West Kiwanis raised about \$17,000),
6. Membership gain – 100 – at 58 (Madison West Kiwanis added two but lost two), and
7. Mid Year attendance – 210 – at 140 (Madison West Kiwanis had 4).
