

This memorial award is intended to provide continuing financial assistance to recipients planning to attend a community college, college, or university. Applications and supporting information become the property of the Kiwanis Club of Carson City, which shall have discretionary authority in all matters pertaining to this award.

Selection Criteria

Recipients are eligible for \$600.00 per semester for eight semesters. Selection will be based upon multiple factors, with special emphasis on the character, personal merit, financial need, and life situation of each applicant. Merit may be demonstrated by leadership in school; civic and other extracurricular activities; academic achievement, dependability and sense of purpose in pursuit of goals.

Qualifications

All applicants must:

- Be US Citizens.
- Be residents of Carson City or the immediate vicinity.
- If selected for the Marilyn-Elaine continuing scholarship, must be enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited community college, college, or university.
- Be a high school senior, high school graduate, or have passed the General Development High School Equivalency Test.
- Must complete the prescribed application form and must submit it to the Scholarship Committee or the Guidance Office at their High School no later than April 20.
- Recipients must maintain a 3.00 or better GPA to continue to receive awards for the term of the scholarship.
- Submit proof of GPA and full time status to the Kiwanis Club by August 10 and December 31 of each successive year. Failure to do so shall result in forfeiture of scholarship.

This Application must be completed in full. Additional pages may be attached if space is insufficient. Limit additional information to 500 words to have the application reviewed.
