  - Streets will close at 3:30 Tuesday June 30<sup>th</sup>.

  - The fireworks are in good shape. We will be setting up Volley Ball post to add a banner acknowledging the Granville Foundation's support of the fireworks. There will be food available and entertainment starting at 6:00. Food will be hot dogs and popcorn.
  - Coughlin will be providing two Corvettes for the parade: Grand Marshal Chuck Peterson, and our scholarship winner Kayla King. Our Ohio District Governor Diana Keplinger will also be in the parade.
  - There will be two handicap parking lots for the parade, the one behind the Village Offices and the lot at the Pilgrim Lutheran Church.
  - There will schedules of events at the food tent.
  - Marc Brockman reported the float is ready to assemble. It will honor our 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Kiwanis. There will be flower arrangements on the float and they will be for sale after the parade.
  - The Vintage Voices have asked us to set up their risers at the Centenary Church on Tuesday. We will receive a donation of \$50 for our efforts.
  - Steak Fry on July 13<sup>th</sup>. If you will attend the meeting and you want to eat steak you will need to sign up at the food tent. Tim will only order a steak for those members that sign up. *If you don't sign up I guess its bread and water.*
