



Jack Sprankling Scholarship Application
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## General Information

**The Award:** A Kiwanis Jack Sprankling Scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating KEY Club member from Oak Park, Thousand Oaks, Newbury Park and Westlake High Schools.

**Stipend:** This is a one-year scholarship of \$1,000 per high school.

**Use of Scholarship:** The scholarships are to be used for tuition, books, and miscellaneous expenses of the recipients to further their academic or career education. The recipient must utilize this scholarship within one year after it is awarded.

**Application:** Application blanks are available at the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks Website at [www.tokiwaniis.org](http://www.tokiwaniis.org). Application must be received or postmarked no later than 5 PM on the third Friday of April.

1. This scholarship is open to:
  - a. Students who wish to attend a trade, technical, or specialized school
  - b. Students who wish to attain a Baccalaureate degree
  - c. Students who wish to attain an Associate Degree
2. The student must have demonstrated a commitment to the community and community service.

### Eligibility:

1. Only complete applications received or postmarked prior to 5 PM on the third Friday of April are eligible.
2. Graduating KEY Club members, active and in good standing at their respect school clubs are eligible.

### Selection:

The final decision of awards will be made by the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks, Jack Sprankling Scholarship Committee. Selection will be made primarily on the basis of proven community involvement and KEY Club participation.

### Presentation of Award:

Recipients will be notified by mail and will be presented their award at a regular meeting of the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks.
