INITIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE KEY CLUB

(due no later than 7-16-18)

\$2000 – will be awarded to be used for tuition, books, or room and board at the vocational technical school, college, or university of choice.

WHO – one or more qualifying Senior High students who are members of the South Fort Myers Key Club, regardless of gender, race, creed, or color; open to any area of study.

HOW – checks are made payable to the institution upon verification of full-time enrollment. Recipients of this award are reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and awarded by the members.

RENEWAL – will need to be completed each year with no students receiving more than 4 years of scholarship – subject to satisfactory academic progress.

DEADLINE – Applications that are mailed must be POSTMARKED on or before July 16, or delivered in person at the time a presentation is done before July 16 or sent via email dated on or before July 16.
