

Art Showcase Rules

1. Contestants must attend public school, private school, a charter school or be homeschooled in Fayette County, or be a member of a club sponsored by The Kiwanis Club of Peachtree City and must be in good standing with their school.
2. All art previously judged in the Kiwanis Art & Music Showcase is ineligible to be entered to be judged a second time.
3. Art can be submitted in the following media: painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, ceramics, sculpture, metal work, graphic design, mixed media and crafts.
4. Each artist may submit one piece with a maximum of 20 entries per school.
5. An art entry may not be copied from a photograph; photocopying is permissible only if the contestant is the photographer.
6. Any art deemed unsuitable or objectionable by the committee will be excluded from the Competition.
7. The entry shall be the original work of the contestant submitting the item and should be completed in free time not in a classroom setting.
8. All artwork must be matted but not framed except for art produced on a canvas or 3D pieces.
9. Winners in Grades 6 through 12 are eligible for the District Competition.
10. First through Third place cash prizes will be awarded in each grade level group.
 - Exceptional
 - Grades 1-3
 - Grades 4-6
 - Grades 7-9
 - Grades 10-12
 - Photography
 - Sculpture/ 3 Dimensional Art/ Craft
11. **Artwork will also be on display on the on the day of the Kiwanis Art and Music Showcase event on March 19, 2018.**
12. **Prize awards will be presented to the winning contestants during the Showcase talent show On Monday, March 19th at 7pm.**
13. **All participants are responsible for claiming their own artwork at the Bridge Community Center the evening of the Showcase on March 19th. There will be no holding of pieces.**
