Relay for Life

What can one person do to change lives of those around him? In 1985, Dr Gordy Klatt from Tacoma took steps to make a difference for cancer patients. As a surgeon he wondered what more could he do to help those with cancer. He took his love for running and used it to raise \$27,000. This was the humble beginning for Relay for Life, a 24 hours event used to raise money in the fight against cancer. Currently, almost 4 million people take part in Relay events in over 5,000 communities in the United States.

In 2003 the Relay for Life raised \$265 million at over 4,300 sites around the world.

The Federal Way Relay for Life is scheduled for Friday June 6, 2014. Our Kiwanis Club will be participating in this worthwhile event along with our Key Club from Thomas Jefferson High School.
