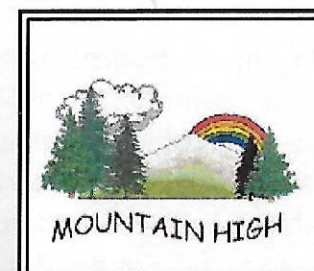

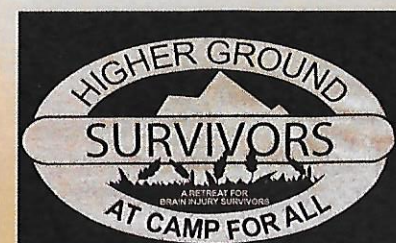

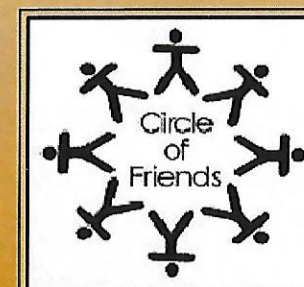

## Mountain High Last Week of August

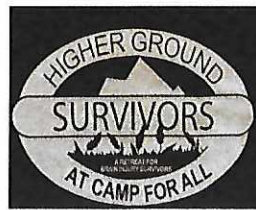
Mountain High in Red River, New Mexico. A 5 day, 4 night camp. Sponsored by Mountain High Foundation, Baylor Rehab and the Faith Mountain Fellowship Church and Texas District Pilot and Anchor Clubs. Started in 1994, by Charlotte and Mike Wilson, who realized that people who had suffered head injuries and their families needed a place to retreat.



Participants stay in local motels and most fly in from adjoining states. Activities include fishing, shopping, dancing, picnics, a talent show, and inspirational times.

Inspired by a Mountain High camp in 1997, three survivors and their parents established Higher Ground camp in Central Texas.

The cost of camp is \$200 plus airfare.



## Higher Ground First Weekend in May

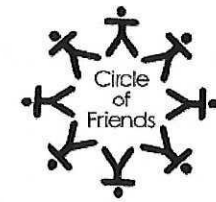
Higher Ground is a 4 day, 3 night camp sponsored by the Texas District Pilot Clubs and Texas District Anchor Clubs, Tideway Residential of Galveston, Pate Rehabilitation, Unified Care Group, and Touchstone Neurorecovery Center.



Higher Ground offers numerous activities including a challenge tower, dance, campfire, karaoke, bingo, arts and crafts, fishing, horse-back riding, baseball, paintball, swimming, and much more.

Survivors, family, and volunteers stay in spacious cabins at the barrier free "**Camp for All**" facility in Burton, TX.

Cost to attend is \$250 for 4 days. Volunteer for the day cost is \$25.



## Circle of Friends First Weekend in November

Circle of Friends camp is a 3 day, 2 night camp sponsored by Texas District Pilot Clubs and Texas District Anchor Clubs.

In 2000, a dream by past Texas District Governor, Joanna Horton, became a reality. While Pilot members were involved in many aspects of the first two camps, Circle of Friends was the first camp for adult TBI survivors to be totally funded and "manned" by Texas District Pilots.

Circle of Friends is located at Camp Shiloh on Lake Bob Sandlin in Pittsburg, TX. The laid-back atmosphere offers a variety of family activities including a hay ride, arts and crafts, games, a dance, and lots of good food cooked and served by Pilots, Co-Pilots, Anchors & Pilot children and grandchildren.

Cost of camp is \$50. Volunteer for the day cost is \$20.
