- Outstanding Achievement Scholarship** - Demonstrates outstanding achievement through leadership and high academic standards (minimum 3.5 GPA), with plans to continue a formal education. **Essay:** How you would make our community a better place to live.
- Rosalie Becker Scholarship** - Demonstrates strong commitment to community service and an interest in finance or accounting. **Essay:** Describe your interest in pursuing a career in finance or accounting.
