

BILL PETTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose:

In memory of Bill Petter; Kirkland businessman, philanthropist, and long-time Kiwanis member, and in recognition of his decades of involvement in various facets of the automotive industry, a memorial scholarship was created in his name beginning in 2013. It's goal is to assist young people who plan to attend an accredited technical school in pursuit of a career in selected facets of *Transportation Technology*.

Scope:

- Scholarships in the amount of \$2,100¹ each will be awarded to selected students; Half to be paid toward tuition at the beginning of Year One, and the remaining half to be paid at the beginning of Year Two.
- Qualifying Areas of Study include:
 - **Auto Repair Technician** - AAS degree or Certificate of Proficiency
 - **Auto Collision Repair Technician** - AAS degree or Certificate of Proficiency
 - **Diesel & Heavy Equipment Technician** - AAS degree or Certificate of Proficiency

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior at any high school located within the geographic boundaries of the Lake Washington School District, and dedicated to achieving a degree in selected facets of Transportation Technology

Requirements :

- Applicant must complete all portions of the attached application
- Applicant must provide a demonstrated history of commitment, mechanical aptitude, responsibility, and work ethic
- Applicant must provide school transcripts and attendance records
- Applicant must be able to provide documentation showing financial need
- The attached application and required documents must be fully completed and received by the Kirkland Kiwanis Foundation scholarship selection committee by **April 21, 2014**

Selection Criteria:

- Academic achievement
- Community involvement
 - Community activities
 - School activities
 - Work activities
 - Kiwanis activities (e.g. high school Key Club)
- Financial Need
- References & Letters of Recommendation
 - School counselor, teacher, career specialist, or administrator (required)
 - Personal letters of reference
 - Work references
